A) 15/02795/FUL.

Applicants:

The Governors of St. Lawrence Church of England Primary School.

Proposed:

Temporary retention of existing mobile classroom at St. Lawrence Church of England Primary School, St. Lawrence Close, Napton.

An extension of the permission for this temporary classroom is required by the school to facilitate the ongoing teaching of the children. Plans are already being considered for a permanent structure when funds allow. The Councillors were minded to support the application.

B) 15/02827/FUL.

Applicant:

Mrs E Ainsworth.

The applicant was present at the meeting.

Proposed:

3 Dormers to front elevation of The Firs, Butt Hill, Napton.

Cllr Veasey reported that the SDC Planning website showed this application as having received an amendment but he was unable to access it.

The applicant was asked if she could expand on the proposed amendment.

It transpired that there is a requirement for alterations to the roof on the rear of the property although the drawings before the council, and being considered at this meeting, do not show these.

So, for clarity, it needs to be noted that the council are considering only an application for 3 dormers to the front elevation to the property.
