Update

Incidents

Southam Ward

Incident 52 - 13/09/2016

On Southfield Road, Southam on the 13th of September a property had been broken into via a fire door. Premises were left secure at 5:45pm the night before – 12th and the break in was discovered at 6:50am the next morning. Nothing believed to have been taken.

Incident 259 - 19/09/2016

At 11am on the 19th of September at Bull Street, Southam, 3 unknown males have caused criminal damage. A full description of the three males is as follows-; white, Irish accents, stocky build early-mid 40s.

Incident 355 - 27/09/2016

A theft from a motorhome was reported on the 27th of September at Browns Bridge Road occurring between Sunday the 18th to Monday 19th the next day. The following items were stolen; - Football training equipment in large bag, kid's football kit – with cones, bibs etc., prescription sunglasses and pair of prescription safety glasses.

Incident 197 - 28/09/2016

On Welsh Road, West, a burglary occurred between 6pm the 24th to 3am 25th of September. Entry was gained and money stolen of mixed currency.

Incident 450 - 29/09/2016

On Mill Crescent, Southam, a burglary occurred on the 29th of September just before 10:16pm where money and cigarettes were stolen.

Incident 285 - 30/09/2016

A Volkswagen Transporter van with keys was reported stolen on the 30th of September in Southam at around 5pm. the vehicle sped off on Welsh Road West, informant was unsure which way, described male as; - white, dark brown hair, possibly Eastern European.

Incident 314 - 30/09/2016

Between the times of 8am and 4:40pm on the 30th of September, offender(s) had stolen tools from informant's van on Pendicke Street, Southam. A Makita Combi drill, Makita impact drill, and drill charger were all stolen.

Incident 92 - 01/10/2016

A van was broken into on Newstead Drive, Southam between the 4:30pm and 4:45pm on the 30th of September. Makita grinder and STIHL saw stolen.

Incident 28 - 12/10/2016

A commercial property theft was reported occurring on Northfield Road, where a break in occurred overnight, sometime between 8pm the 11th of October and 5:30am the next day. Cigarettes were stolen.

Long Itchington Ward

Incident 80 - 12/09/2016

On Leigh Crescent, Long Itchington, a burglary was reported by informant occurring the night before – the 11th of September around midnight. The back-door glass window had been smashed and the back-door key was also taken. Nothing was taken as the resident scared them off.

Incident 399 - 14/09/2016

Between 9am to 4pm on the 14th of September unknown offender(s) broke into driver's side window of a lorry. They had then stolen informant's bag. Occurred on Church Road, Long Itchington.

Incident 314 - 20/09/2016

A Mitsubishi L200 Car had just been reported stolen along with keys just before 6pm on the 20th of September on Church Road, Long Itchington. Offender(s) drove car in direction of Leamington. The vehicle was later found abandoned in Grindle Road, Coventry.

Incident 252 - 30/09/2016

A burglary of a shed occurred in the Model Village, Long Itchington on the 30th of September at approximately 3:30pm. A neighbour disturbed the offender who then made good their escape. He drove off in a Silver Vauxhall. Nothing believed to have been taken.

Incident 286 - 03/10/2016

On Collingham Lane, Long Itchington, a theft was reported by informant of a turning mirror outside their property sometime on Thursday 29th of September.

Incident 336 - 06/10/2016

Between 9:30am and 6pm on the 6th of October offender(s) had stolen a wood chipper from a carpark whilst left unattended on Stockton Road, Stockton.

Incident 87 - 07/10/2016

On Wulfstan Drive, Long Itchington, between 5pm and 7:30am on 6th and the 7th of October, someone had broken into a Silver Vauxhall Navano and the following tools were stolen; - STIHL Disk cutter and circular saw, Makita SDS drills, Jigsaw drill, 12V drill with 3 batteries and charger, and a Ryobi grinder.

Incident 354 - 07/10/2016

A caravan had been broken into and vandalised on Church Road, Long Itchington between the 5th of October 12pm to 12pm the next day. Door had been forced open, curtains ripped off and blind casings damaged.

Incident 109 - 12/10/2016

Offender(s) entered insecure wooden shed and stolen a leaf blower and chainsaw on Southam Road, Ufton, between the 6th and 11th of October.

Incident 267 - 14/10/2016

A Burglary occurred on Church Road, Long Itchington where a shed was broken into and a STIHL Kombi engine was stolen between the 9am on the 7th of and 9am on the 10th of October.

Napton Ward

Incident 337 - 03/09/2016

At Chapel Green, Napton, unknown offenders have gained entry to an insecure outbuilding and have then stolen a Green Kawasaki Quad Bike. The bike was subsequently found near the roadside as informant heard noise, went out and disturbed the offenders. A neighbour saw the offender's vehicle driving off and described it as a Dark Green Single Cab pickup or possibly a Toyota.

Incident 46 - 06/09/2016

At Hillside, Napton, informant had their car roof damaged and the following items were stolen: A Peltor helmet, Red ski jacket, Silver and White 'Matches'

and matching ski trousers, a pair of trainers, Silverstone jacket and other clothes. The incident happened between the 7th and 8th of September.

Incident 85 - 06/09/2016

A bicycle was stolen in Napton from a secluded courtyard where it was chained up from 9pm on the 5th of September and discovered stolen the next day at 7:30am.

Incident 74 - 13/09/2016

Informant reported theft of a Quad bike on Napton Road, Stockton from a farm outbuilding sometime between Friday and Monday morning – 9th to the 12th of September.

Incident 355 - 15/09/2016

On Stockton Road, a vehicle had been damaged and broken into between 10am and 3pm on the 15th of September. The side door had been forced and the following items were stolen; - Battery drills (Makita), 18V standard B drill, 18V SDS drill, 18V impact drill, 2 chargers, 18V circular saw, 2 x 10.8V drills and a laser level.

Incident 44 - 26/09/2016

A theft from a vehicle occurred on Shuckburgh Road, Napton on Thursday the 22nd of September and the following items were stolen; - Galvanised Camping Mug, Bosch Core Blue Drill, Testo Thermal Imaging Camera.

Incident 140 - 27/09/2016

A theft occurred on Napton Road of 4x5 alloys and tyres to fit a BMWx5. CCTV footage filmed 3 males in a black/ grey 4x4 pulling up and removing wheels. Believed to have been taken between the afternoon of the 24th and 27th of September 11:30am.

Incident 166 - 27/09/2016

At Chapel Green, Stockton, a burglary occurred between 10:30am and 12:30pm on the 27th of September where entry was gained into a garage and the following listed property was taken – Ifor Williams Aluminium Trailer Hitch on Single Axle (last four digits of serial number – 2P8E), STIHL chainsaws (x3), STIHL hedge trimmer, Red Honda generator, Green Hayter lawnmower and a Rotovator.

Incident 50 - 28/09/2016

Informant reported a van had been broken into on Victoria Terrace, Stockton, at around 6-6:30pm. Various power tools had been stolen.

Incident 42 - 29/09/2016

A theft occurred at Greaves Cottages, Stockton of an Ivor Williams Single Axle Trailer from rear of property. The trailer was stolen on the night of the 27th of September.

Incident 117 - 14/10/2016

A burglary occurred on Southam Road, Napton, where informant reported a shed had been entered and the offender(s) had stolen a Petrol strimmer. This occurred sometime between the 10th of October and 11am on the 14th of October.

Incident 135 - 14/10/2016

A burglary occurred on Southam Road, Napton on the 14th of October where offender(s) entered shed and stolen a 400AMP Welder, a Shredder/ Chipper, Copper tubes and various hand tools.

Fenny Compton Ward

Incident 260 - 01/09/2016

Between 7:45am and 5pm on the 1st of October unknown offender(s) were reported to have conducted an untidy search of a property on High Street, Fenny Compton. Several pieces of jewellery were stolen then offender(s) made good their escape in an unknown direction.

Incident 155 - 09/09/2016

On Shuckburgh Road, Priors Marston, an informant reported his vehicle had been stolen on the 9th of September. The car was driven off towards Napton, it was later found abandoned, Wood End, Coventry.

Incident 442 - 09/09/2016

On Lower End, Priors Hardwick, a theft of a green/ black Kawasaki Motorbike was reported on the 9th of September. The vehicle was later recovered by Police.

Incident 299 - 02/10/2016

In Avon Dassett an informant reported that a van had been broken into and the following items were stolen – Dewalt Drill, impact driver, Adjustable Pliers, Screw Drivers and various accessories. Thought to have occurred between the 25th and the 30th of September.

Incident 46 - 07/10/2016

On School Lane, Priors Marston on the 7th of October, informant reported rear windows of a car had been smashed and three drill sets had been stolen

along with their sockets. The following Makita drills were stolen; - White drill, impact driver, blue Cordless drill, three Lithium Batteries and charger also taken, along with a Halford socket set - thought to have occurred between 9pm on the 6th to 6:45am on the 7th of October.

The risk of keeping easily transportable high value belongings in cars such as power tools can't be overstated looking at all the reoccurring incidents that have been occurring in and around Southam over the past few months. Never risk leaving your tools in your vehicle for extended periods of time, thieves know to target vehicles and especially vans as people often store their tools and equipment in them overnight, so don't give them the opportunity. Lock you tools away in a secure location - part of main property if possible. Ideally, always take out anything susceptible to thieves from your vehicle every night and always be vigilant, both you and your property can be just as vulnerable in the middle of the day so NEVER leave keys in a car even if you are close by, and NEVER leave desirable property out on show when you are not around.
