

Notice of phase 2 ground investigation works

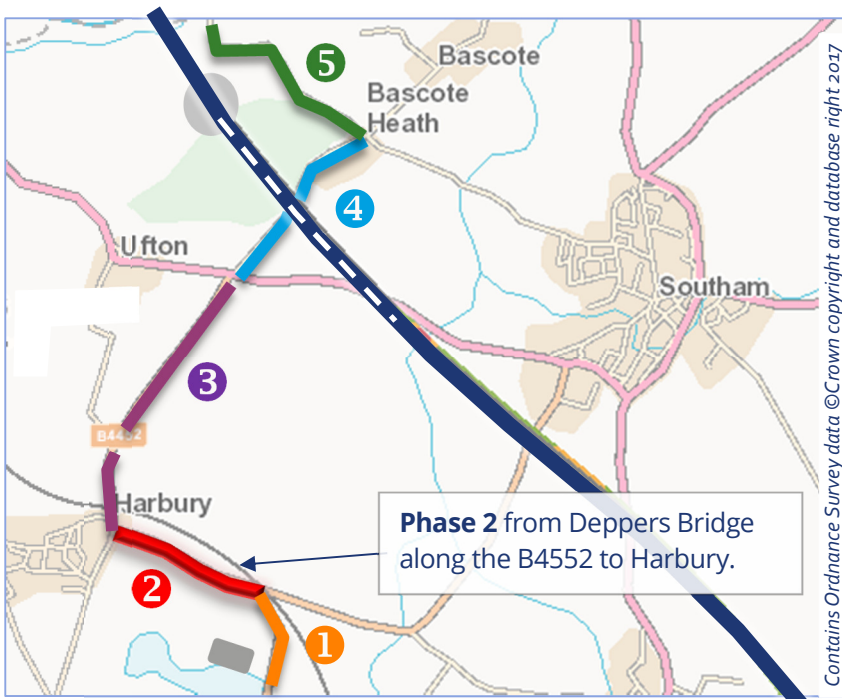

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Initial works have now started and are carried out by LM – a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and J. Murphy & Sons.

We will be in your area to continue our ground investigation works. These surveys will allow us to identify utilities located in the road in advance of an underground power line that will be laid next year from the electricity substation near Harbury to the Long Itchington wood tunnel north entrance.

The work is being carried out in 5 phases (see map below). The **2nd phase** starts on **13th December from Deppers Bridge along the B4552 to Harbury**. The road will be closed for one week and for up to two weeks in the new year. Access will be maintained for all households and businesses along the route. An agreed and clearly signed local diversion will be in place. **There will be no changes to school bus services during this phase of the works.**

Duration of works

Phase 2 from 13th December for one week and up to two weeks in the new year.

Daytime working hours from 8.00am to 5.00pm.

Our contractors may also be on site for up to one hour beforehand to set up the works.

What to expect

Some noise from on-site machinery during working hours.

Disruption to traffic. A diversion will be in place during these works.

Maintained access for emergency service and to properties and pedestrians along the route.

Inform you in advance of any changes.
