On the 25th April 2019 officers from the Safer Neighbourhood Teams and Operational Support Unit carried out a warrant at the above detailed premises. The warrant was carried out due to intelligence surrounding drugs on the premises.

A quantity of cannabis was located within the living quarters of the property totalling 17 ounces. The manager of the premises Sam HAWKINS was questioned regarding this and appeared at Mid Warwickshire Magistrates Court on 7th June 2019. The offence charged was Possession of Controlled Substance Class B.

HAWKINS entered a Guilty plea and was fined £326 with £135 in costs.


Resident heard noise at 0145 hrs. The next morning it was discovered that there had been an attempt to force a window.
