Defibrillators - March 24

1. AED Training Course

- It was asked whether NPC would be interested in offering an AED training course to anyone else in the Parish?
 - i. I have found Warwickshire Hearts (a charity) that offer community CPR/AED training for free but obviously welcome donations at the session and via PayPal.
 - **1.** NPC can, under Section 137, donate to a local charity that provides services benefiting the local community.
 - 2. 23/24 limit is £9.93 per electorate * 991 electorates = £9,840.63
 - 3. Note this is the amount of precept money that can be used for purposes for which the PC has no other specific statutory power, like donations to charities that benefit the community.
 - **ii.**—I have researched these courses, and I cannot find anywhere that would provide a free AED training course for Parish Councils.
 - **iii.**—Having enquired with 2 course providers (Onsite First Aid Training and St John Ambulance) the costs are:
 - 1.—Onsite First Aid Training 30 delegates (max) £899.00 + VAT
 - 2.—St John Ambulance 24 delegates (max) £2,470.00 + VAT

2. External Cabinets for AEDs

- It was asked to consider the benefit of putting the two units at Napton Village Stores and Cross Roads Garage into external cabinets so they can be available 24/7/365?
 - i. The cost for an external box is around £450 £500 per unit (not including installation or electrician)
 - **ii.** The permission of the property owner would be required, and electric hookup would probably be required at the expense of the owner (if willing to volunteer to pay) or NPC.
