3a – Comment to SDC Planning Committee for Application 23/02105/FUL <ul style="list-style-type: none">NPC used delegated authority to the clerk to provide the below comment to SDC planning committee regarding application 23/02105/FUL.Napton PC understands the urgent need for SEND schools but does not believe this location is appropriate considering its rural setting. NPC's main concern is the inevitable increase in traffic along a single-track road that is already in poor condition. Recent temporary roadworks that diverted traffic down Priors Marston Road, a key route to the proposed school, caused daily mayhem with verges badly damaged and cars mounting the pavement to pass other vehicles. A permanent increase in traffic along this road, at the beginning and end of the school day would not be sustainable. NPC has no confidence in the veracity of the travel plan provided and note that this location is not served by any form of public transport. NPC are perplexed that such an application, which will have a knock-on effect to the parish of Napton, was never submitted to NPC for consultation. NPC would like it noted that Napton already has a SEND school located in its parish and is not against the school but the inappropriate location.

On that note, NPC request a condition that no extension of the building be permitted on the side adjacent to the footpath.
